

PART I – GENERAL PROVISIONS

SUBPART A

NOTICE TO BIDDERS

Sealed bids for the installation of outdoor warning sirens in Martindale, Caldwell County, Texas will be received by the Guadalupe-Blanco River Authority (GBRA) at the reception area 933 E. Court Street, Seguin, TX 78155 until 11:00 a.m., Friday, December 1, 2017.

Contractor shall furnish all labor, material and equipment and perform all work required to install outdoor warning sirens. Bids will be publicly opened at that time. Any bid received after the time set for the opening thereof will be returned to the bidder unopened.

Bids must be submitted in a sealed envelope and labeled as follows:

- (1) IFB - MARTINDALE OUTDOOR WARNING SIRENS
- (2) Bid Submission & Bid Opening Date / Time: Friday, December 1, 2017 – 11:00 A.M.
- (3) Name and Address of Bidder

There will be a *pre-bid conference* beginning at 10:00 a.m., November 21, 2017, to be held at conference room of Martindale Water Supply Corporation, 206 Main St., Martindale, Caldwell County, Texas 78655. Attendance is not mandatory. However, prospective bidders are **HIGHLY ENCOURAGED** to attend the conference.

Additional items that may be of interest to prospective bidders (photographs and maps) are available for inspection at GBRA office, 933 E. Court Street, Seguin, TX, on Monday through Friday, 9:00 a.m. – 12:00 noon and 1:00 p.m. – 4:00 p.m.

All bids require a bid guarantee in the amount of not less than five percent (5%) of the total bid. Requirements are outlined in PART I, Subpart B, Instructions to Bidders. The successful bidder will be required to sign a contract 5 (five) workdays after receipt of Notice of Award.

GBRA reserves the right to reject any and all bids. Bids providing less than 30 calendar days for acceptance will not be considered and will be rejected. Telegraphic or facsimile (Fax) bids, modifications, or withdrawals are not authorized.

GBRA is the Contracting Local Organization (CLO) responsible for soliciting and awarding a local contract for this project.
