# STATEWIDE MONITORING STATISTICS




## SINCE PROGRAM INCEPTION:

- Total of ~26,700 sampling events
- ~1,310 sampling locations
- 4,341 water quality monitors certified
- 23,150 volunteer monitoring hours



# STATEWIDE MONITORING STATISTICS



**IN 2008:**

- Trained ~270 new monitors (up 7% from 2007) and 7 new trainers
- Supported ~1,400 active participants in volmon program (incl. students)
- Logged ~3,600 volunteer hours
- Conducted ~1,826 sampling events (up 7% from 2007)
