

Coordinated Monitoring Meeting – March 24, 2016

Meeting Notes

1. Metals in Water sampling was removed from station 12592 (Guadalupe River at Old San Antonio Road/FM 766 West of Cuero) for FY17.
2. An Aquatic Life Monitoring Event, Organics in Water & Organics in Sediment analysis were removed from station 13657 (Sandies Creek 100 FT Downstream of County Highway 1.9 MI Upstream from Birds Creek 2.0 MI NE of Westhoff) for FY 17.
3. Quarterly monitoring at station 12672 (Upper San Marcos River Immediately Upstream of IH 35 Bridge at San Marcos) will change for Region 11 (Submitting Entry WC/Collecting Entity FO) to the GBRA (Submitting Entity GB/Collecting Entity GB) in FY 17.
4. A new Aquatic Life Monitoring event will be added to the coordinated monitoring schedule at Station 20509 (Town Branch 182 Meters East and 23 Meters South From the Intersection of Scheh Street and Park Road in Lockhart City Park) to investigate the effects of dissolved oxygen concerns in the 2014 Texas Integrated Report on the aquatic life in segment 1810A (Town Creek) in FY 17.
5. Station 12660 (Blanco River at Low Water Crossing at CR 174/Fulton Ranch Rd), above the proposed wastewater discharge on Deer Creek, will no longer be monitored for TKN by the Wimberley Valley Watershed Association.
6. A new monitored station will be requested by the GBRA at the Deer Creek Confluence of the Blanco River at Rocky River Ranch to be monitored by the Wimberley Valley Watershed Association in FY 17.
7. Two additional 24 Hour Dissolved Oxygen Monitoring Events will be collected by the Wimberley Valley Watershed Association at Station 12673 (Cypress Creek at Confluence with the Blanco River) in FY 17.
8. Secchi Disc Transparency (STORET 00078) will be added to the Table A7.2 Measurement Performance Specifications for UGRA and monitored quarterly at station 15113 (Guadalupe River off Split Rock Rd off SH 27 2.6 KM Downstream of Flatrock Dam) along with the other field parameters in order to capture background information prior to the initiation of a new quarry operation immediately upstream in FY 17.
9. The Aquatic Life Monitoring event at Station 12678 (Johnson Creek at SH 39 In Ingram) will be removed from the coordinated monitoring schedule in FY 17.
10. A new Aquatic Life Monitoring event will be added to the coordinated monitoring schedule at Station 12684 (South Fork Guadalupe Adjacent to Hunt Lions Park) to investigate the effects of dissolved oxygen concerns in the 2014 Texas Integrated Report on the aquatic life in segment 1818 (South Fork of the Guadalupe River).
11. Additional Aquatic Life Monitoring events will be considered for FY 17 by the GBRA on Rebecca Creek near Canyon Lake, Coleto Creek near Yorktown, Peach Creek, & Elm Creek contingent upon additional project funding availability from the TCEQ.
