## **Poultry Study Public Meeting set for March 24 in Gonzales**

**SEGUIN-** Poultry operators and members of the general public are invited to attend a meeting at 6:30 p.m. on Tuesday, March 24 in the Norwest Bank meeting room at 301 St. Joseph Street in Gonzales. The purpose of the meeting is to explain a study being conducted by the Texas Natural Resource Conservation Commission (TNRCC) on how poultry operations impact water quality, and to obtain input from the poultry operators and the public.

The Texas Legislature directed TNRCC to conduct the study, which is being carried out under the Clean Rivers Program. The Guadalupe River basin and the Cypress River basin were selected as target sites for the study due to their significant poultry operations.

The Guadalupe-Blanco River Authority is TNRCC's contractor for performance of the Clean Rivers Program in the Guadalupe River Basin, and will provide data to help TNRCC meet its poultry study requirements.
