The Coleta Creek Division operates the Coleta Creek Park and Reservoir 13 miles southwest of Victoria. The 3,100 acre reservoir provides cooling water to the CP&L electric generating plant near Fannin. The recreation area and park is a popular location for camping, fishing, boating and outdoor education.
