GBRA to lower Lake Wood

SEGUIN----The level of Lake Wood (H-5) near Gonzales will be six (6) to twelve (12) inches below normal beginning Friday, August 21 and will continue through the weekend and for several days next week, according to Larry Moltz, manager of GBRA Hydro Operations.

Moltz said the lake lowering is necessary to enable GBRA hydroelectric crews to make repairs to the Keifer Slough crossing. During this period, the lake level will fluctuate due to the H-5 hydroelectric plant operating schedule.

Moltz advises anyone using Lake Wood for recreation purposes during this time to exercise caution, since lower lake levels may expose debris and other potential hazards that are normally underwater.

The public is advised that scheduled operations may be canceled or adjusted in the event of adverse weather conditions.
