### **Media Advisory**

**WHO:** GBRA director Ashley Turberville, representing Gonzales County, GBRA general manager Bill West, and management and staff from GBRA's Hydroelectric Division

**WHAT:** Startup of H-4 Hydroelectric Plant following installation of new turbine. This completes a six-month project to replace the original turbine built and installed in 1929. This historic plant has provided a reliable source of electricity to residents of the Guadalupe River basin for almost seventy years.

**WHEN:** 8:30 a.m., Tuesday, October 6

### **Directions:**

#### *From Seguin:*

- ⇒ East on Hwy. 90-A to Hwy 80 at Belmont (Hwy 80 is 16.3 miles from the Hwy 90-A and 123 Bypass intersection)
- ⇒ Turn right on Hwy 80 and proceed 2.2. miles to FM 466
- ⇒ Turn left on FM 466 and proceed 4.9 miles to the plant entrance road (look for cattle guard with GBRA sign on fence)
- ⇒ Turn left on the entrance road and proceed 1.4 miles to the plant

#### *From Gonzales:*

- ⇒ South on Hwy 183 to Hwy 97
- ⇒ Hwy 97 is 0.9 miles after crossing the city park river bridge
- ⇒ Turn right on Hwy 97 and proceed 5.9 miles to FM 466 at cost
- ⇒ Turn right on FM 466 and proceed 7.6 miles to the plant entrance road (look for cattle guard with GBRA sign on fence)
- ⇒ Turn right on entrance road and go 1.4 miles to the plant

#### *From Nixon:*

- ⇒ North on Hwy 80 to FM 466
- ⇒ Right on FM 466. Proceed 4.9 miles to plant entrance road (look for cattle guard with GBRA sign on fence)
- ⇒ Left on entrance road and proceed 1.4 miles to plant.
