## **Archery Hunting Pilot Program approved at GBRA's Coletto Creek Park**

SEGUIN-The Guadalupe-Blanco River Authority Board of Directors recently approved a pilot program to hunt antlerless deer and feral hogs during the 1998-1999 hunting season at GBRA's Coletto Creek Park and Reservoir Division, located off Highway 59 between Victoria and Goliad.

Four weekend hunts, restricted to the use of archery equipment only, will be held on December 5-6 and 12-13, and January 9-10 and 16-17.

The purpose of these hunts is to reduce the size of the deer herd that has grown beyond the carrying capacity of the Reservoir's lands, and to reduce the numbers of feral hogs that are damaging Reservoir property.

These public hunts will provide an opportunity to harvest two antlerless deer and unlimited feral hogs. Hunters may apply individually, or as a group with a maximum of four people per party. Each individual/group will be assigned their own hunting area.

Hunters will be chosen at a random drawing at noon on October 26.

To enter the drawing, send a postcard with name, mailing address, daytime phone, number in hunting party (maximum of 4), and preferred hunt date(s) to GBRA Coletto Creek Park and Reservoir, P. O. Box 68, Fannin, TX, 77960. Postcards must be received prior to the October 26 drawing.

Hunters selected will be notified by the Coletto Creek staff and must send in a non-refundable \$50.00 permit fee per person to reserve their hunt weekend.
