GBRA ANNOUNCES TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF LAKE WOOD RECREATION AREA

SEGUIN.....Mark Henneke, assistant chief ranger of the Guadalupe Blanco River Authority's Lake Wood Recreation Area near Gonzales announced today that all facilities and boat launching ramps will be closed temporarily to allow for cleanup and repair of damages resulting from the record-setting flood along the Guadalupe River on Sunday, October 18.

Henneke said the flood completely inundated the park, causing damage to the headquarters building and grounds.

"Once flood waters have receded, we will conduct a complete assessment of damages to determine the extent of repairs needed to get the park back in operation," said Henneke. "Our primary concern is the safety of the customers using our facilities."
