Lake Wood Recreation Area reopens for public use

SEGUIN- The Guadalupe-Blanco River Authority's Lake Wood Recreation Area, which has been closed to repair damage caused by the October 1998 flood, is once again open for public use said Mark Henneke, assistant chief ranger at GBRA.

The facility is located approximately four miles west of Gonzales off US Highway 90-A and offers shaded, full hookup multi-use campsites as well as primitive, undeveloped sites, a playground, restroom facilities, and other outdoor recreation opportunities. Henneke said visitors will also find several changes since the flood including newly-graveled park roads and redeveloped campsites. Park rangers are responsible for daily operations and two on-site park 'hosts' provide 24-hour supervision.

The 488-acre Lake Wood remains closed to on-the-water usage until a drawdown and visual inspection of the Lake, scheduled for Saturday February 20. If no flood-related hazards are found, Lake Wood should reopen shortly thereafter.
