## **Lake Nolte lower for weekend inspection of debris removal**

SEGUIN.....The Guadalupe-Blanco River Authority will begin lowering the level of Lake Nolte (Meadow Lake) late Thursday, May 20, to conduct an inspection of the flood debris removal project and remove items below the water's surface.

Lake Nolte will be six feet below normal from 7 a.m. Friday, May 21 through Saturday, May 22 and will return to its normal elevation on Sunday, said GBRA director of project development David Welsch.

"Regency Construction, Inc. has substantially completed their portion of the debris removal project," said Welsch. "This lowering will permit us to conduct a final reconnaissance and inspection of their work and enable Regency to remove items that were difficult to reach with the lake at normal pool."

Welsch said GBRA is encouraging lake residents to use this opportunity to clean and remove items along their shoreline areas.

"Next week, after reviewing the results of the inspection, GBRA will decide when Lake Nolte will be opened for public use. Based on recommendations from the lake homeowners' associations, we will also consider a date when the lake may be lowered for extended periods for shoreline repairs," Welsch said.

Area residents are reminded that Lakes Dunlap, McQueeney, Placid and Nolte are presently restricted from public use of motor-powered watercraft, as authorized by GBRA's Board of Directors.
