LAKE MCQUEENEY LOWERING BEGINS OCT. 10 FOR SPILLGATE REPAIRS

SEGUIN, TX – October 4, 1999. Lake McQueeney will be lowered approximately twelve inches below normal level on Sunday night October 10 for repair crews to begin work on two spillgates damaged during the October 1998 flood.

Guadalupe-Blanco River Authority hydro system manager Allen Ognoskie said the firm of C. C. Carlton, Inc. will have crews on site beginning Monday, October 11 to start the repair process. The estimated completion date for this work is December 31, 1999.

Anyone using Lake McQueeney for recreation purposes during the lake lowering should exercise caution, since lower elevations may expose debris or other potential hazards that would normally be underwater. In addition, GBRA may cancel or adjust scheduled operations in the event of adverse weather conditions.
