## **MCQUEENEY LOWERING SCHEDULE ADJUSTED FOR WED. NOV. 10- OTHER LAKE LOWERINGS PROCEED AS SCHEDULED**

SEGUIN, TX – November 9, 1999. Lowering of Area Lakes for shoreline repairs and clean up by homeowners is proceeding as scheduled.

### **DUNLAP AND MCQUEENEY**

Lakes Dunlap and McQueeney remain approximately 4 feet below normal level.

### **The Lake McQueeney schedule issued earlier has changed as follows:**

Lake McQueeney will be approximately 6 feet below normal at 8:00 a.m. on Wednesday morning, November 10, 1999, and will refill at a rate of approximately one foot per 8-10 hours to the 4 foot low level. It will remain at the 4 foot low level until refilling begins on Sunday, November 14.

It will still remain one foot below normal as repairs to the McQueeney gates continue through the end of the year.

### **PLACID AND NOLTE**

Lowering of Nolte Lake will begin Thursday morning, with lowering of Placid beginning on Friday. Stronger currents will be experienced during this time.

Each lake will be approximately 6 feet below normal as of 8:00 a.m. on Saturday, November 13<sup>th</sup>, and will refill to approximately 4 feet below normal.

Nolte will begin refilling to normal level on Tuesday, November 16<sup>th</sup>.

Placid will begin refilling on Sunday, November 21<sup>st</sup>. Placid will remain approximately 1 foot below normal level as repairs to the Placid gates continue through the end of the year.

### Notes:

1. Remove or secure boats in advance.
2. Turn off or remove water pumps
3. Be aware of debris that can become dislodged during filling or refilling
4. Boating or recreation, or use of lakes at night is not recommended.
5. Be aware of increased currents during periods that lakes are filled or lowered.
