## **GBRA promotes McCall to Regional Laboratory Director**

SEGUIN- The Guadalupe-Blanco River Authority has promoted Mike McCall to Regional Laboratory Director for the GBRA Regional Laboratory in Seguin.

McCall will serve as training coordinator of laboratory personnel in areas of biology, water quality and hydrology, perform laboratory analysis on water, wastewater and environmental samples, and manage budgets and proposals for upcoming projects and events for the GBRA Regional Laboratory. He will also conduct water quality investigations with such programs as the Clean Rivers Program and the Instream Flow Incremental Methodology (I.F.I.M.) study to determine instream uses exclusive of bay and estuary freshwater inflows.

McCall joined GBRA in 1991 as laboratory analyst and field technician for the regional laboratory team, and holds a Bachelor of Science Degree in Range Science from Texas A & M University.

McCall is a trained field technician for water quality monitoring programs, including the Clean Rivers Program. He is a certified trainer for the Texas Watch Program, a coordinated volunteer water quality monitoring project. He promotes Texas Watch by working with volunteers who monitor water quality in Texas rivers and streams in the Guadalupe River Basin. "I've trained students at a very young age, adults in their 70's, and every age in between. Everyone wants to learn more about their water, and the Texas Watch Program is a wonderful teaching tool for people of any age," said McCall.

McCall also serves as a board member for the Seguin Outdoor Learning Center Board, the Buck Fever Organization, and is an active member of the Guadalupe County Wildlife Management Association and the Texas Water Utilities Association.
