## Lake Dunlap to be lowered twice in July

SEGUIN---Beginning the evening of Sunday, July 15 through Friday, July 20, the level of Lake Dunlap will be approximately eighteen (18) inches below normal so that Guadalupe-Blanco River Authority hydroelectric crews can perform spillgate inspection and maintenance, said Allen Ognoskie, GBRA hydroelectric system manager.

Work should be completed and Lake Dunlap returned to its normal level late Friday, Ognoskie said.

Lake Dunlap will be lowered again approximately twelve (12) inches on Wednesday, July 25 and Thursday, July 26 and will return to normal level late Thursday evening.

GBRA's hydroelectric lakes are popular recreation spots, especially during the summer months. Ognoskie advises anyone using Lake Dunlap during this time to exercise caution, since lower lake levels may expose debris and other potential hazards that are normally underwater.

The public is advised that scheduled operations may be canceled or adjusted in the event of adverse weather conditions.
