Meadow Lake lowering scheduled November 11-16

SEGUIN---Beginning Sunday evening, November 11 through Friday, November 16 the level of Meadow Lake (Lake Nolte) in Seguin will be approximately eighteen (18) inches below normal. This will enable Guadalupe-Blanco River Authority hydroelectric crews to conduct spillgate inspection and maintenance, said Allen Ognoskie, GBRA hydroelectric system manager.

Work should be completed and Meadow Lake returned to its normal level late Friday evening.

Ognoskie advises anyone using Meadow Lake during this time to exercise caution, since lower lake levels may expose debris and other potential hazards that are normally underwater.

The public is advised that scheduled operations may be canceled or adjusted in the event of adverse weather conditions.
