Lake Placid to be Lowered Monday for Repairs

SEGUIN----Beginning Monday, October 13, Lake Placid in Seguin will be approximately twelve inches below normal so that the hired contracting company can begin repairing both spill gates that were damaged during the July 2002 flood.

According to Allen Ognoskie, GBRA hydro system manager, the lake will remain twelve inches below normal through December 2003. Anyone using Lake Placid for recreation purposes during this time needs to exercise caution, since lower lake levels may expose debris and other potential hazards normally underwater.

The public is advised that scheduled operations may be canceled or adjusted in the event of adverse weather conditions.
