SEGUIN---- Lake Placid will be lowered to one foot below the normal elevation beginning Sunday evening, May 9, in order for a contractor to perform maintenance to a spill gate. The current schedule calls for Lake Placid to remain one foot low throughout the week and return to normal elevation on Friday, May 14.

However, in the event that maintenance is completed before Friday, Lake Placid will be returned to normal elevation at that time, according to Allen Ognoskie, GBRA hydro system manager.

Residents and anyone using Lake Placid for recreation during this period are advised to be aware of changing lake elevations and to exercise caution, since lower lake levels may expose debris and other potential hazards that are normally underwater.

The public is advised that scheduled operations may be canceled or adjusted in the event of adverse weather conditions.
