SEGUIN- The Guadalupe-Blanco River Authority (GBRA) and Hays County have been awarded a Texas Water Development Board (TWDB) Regional Facility Planning Fund Grant for the purpose of developing a regional wastewater facility plan for the eastern portion of Hays County.

The purpose of the project is to evaluate existing and proposed wastewater treatment facilities as to their location, capacity and ability to expand to meet the needs of the explosive growth occurring in this area of Hays County. Numerous developments have been proposed in or near the cities of Kyle, Buda, Niederwald and Umland. As the area continues to grow, water availability and water quality issues become increasingly important to the residents and businesses in the area and to downstream property owners.

The project's first Stakeholders committee meeting will be held Tuesday, August 17 at 2:00 p.m. at the Buda City Council Chambers at 121 N. Main, Buda, Texas. The stakeholder committee is vital to the project and will assure that all perspectives are considered and there is feedback from all interested parties. This meeting will be open to the public. The consulting firm of PBS&J will be presenting baseline information on the project area and discussing the scope, objectives and project timeline.
