GBRA Schedules Maintenance on Dunlap Dam

Lake Level To Fluctuate For Several Weeks

SEGUIN----Beginning Sunday evening, August 22, the elevation of Lake Dunlap will be approximately 12 to 15 inches below normal so that Guadalupe-Blanco River Authority (GBRA) hydroelectric crews can conduct safety and operational inspections and maintenance on each of the three Dunlap spill gates.

Lake Dunlap will return to the normal elevation Friday evening, August 27 and remain at that level throughout the weekend.

Similar level fluctuations will occur on Sunday and Friday evenings for the next several weeks, said Allen Ognoskie, GBRA hydro system manager.

GBRA will inform area media and post a news release on its website at www.gbra.org when this work is completed.

Anyone using Lake Dunlap for recreation purposes during this time should exercise caution, since lower lake levels may expose debris and other potential hazards that are normally underwater.

The public is advised that high river flows or heavy rain events will postpone this scheduled work.
