Lake McQueeney to be Lowered Wednesday for Repairs

SEGUIN----Beginning Wednesday, February 9 at 9:00 AM, Lake McQueeney will be approximately twenty inches below normal to place buoys marking the restricted area upstream of the dam. According to Allen Ognoskie, GBRA hydro system manager, the lake will remain twenty inches below normal through 1:00 PM in the afternoon. The public is advised that scheduled operations may be canceled or adjusted in the event of adverse weather conditions.

Hydroelectric lakes Dunlap, McQueeney, Placid, Meadow (Nolte), Gonzales (H-4) and Lake Wood (H-5) in Comal, Guadalupe and Gonzales counties remain closed to the public until February 17, 2005.
