Lake McQueeney Lowering Extended GBRA Advises Work May Be Completed Before or After May 12 Target Date

SEGUIN---- The level of Lake McQueeney will continue to be approximately 12 to 18 inches below normal on weekdays until approximately Friday, May 12 so that Guadalupe-Blanco River Authority (GBRA) hydroelectric crews can complete routine maintenance to the dam.

Lake McQueeney will be raised 6-8 inches beginning Friday evening, May 5 for weekend recreation use, and lowered again Sunday night, May 7.

The public is advised that these scheduled operations may be completed before May 12, or may need to be extended for an additional period of time. When work is completed, the lake will be returned to normal level.

Operations may also be adjusted or canceled in the event of adverse weather conditions.

GBRA advises anyone using Lake McQueeney for recreation purposes during this time to exercise caution, since lower lake levels may expose debris and other potential hazards that are normally underwater.
