Lake Gonzales (H-4) to be Lowered May 21 for Repairs

SEGUIN---- Beginning the evening of Sunday, May 21, 2006 Lake Gonzales (H-4) will be lowered approximately 18 to 24 inches below normal so that Guadalupe-Blanco River Authority (GBRA) hydroelectric crews can perform routine maintenance to the dam.

The lake level will remain low throughout the week during maintenance, but will then be raised to normal level on Friday, May 26 for the Memorial Holiday weekend.

Beginning the evening of Monday, May 29, 2006 Lake Gonzales (H-4) will be lowered again approximately 18 to 24 inches below normal so that crews can resume maintenance to the dam through Friday, June 2, 2006.

The public is advised that these scheduled operations may be completed before June 2, or may need to be extended for an additional period of time. When work is completed, the lake will be returned to normal level.

Operations may also be adjusted or canceled in the event of adverse weather conditions.

GBRA advises anyone using Lake Gonzales (H-4) for recreation purposes during this time to exercise caution, since lower lake levels may expose debris and other potential hazards that are normally underwater.
