Children who love to fish only have two more weeks to wait until the 13th Annual Coletto Creek Kids Fishing Tournament. The event, which is jointly sponsored by the Guadalupe-Blanco River Authority and the Texas Parks & Wildlife Department, will be held on Saturday, June 3, from 7AM to Noon at GBRA's Coletto Creek Park located on U.S. Highway 59 South between Victoria and Goliad.

The event is open to all children between the ages of 2 and 16 said Wilfred Korth, chief ranger at Coletto Creek. All children will need to register to fish but no registration fee will be charged. Participants will only need to pay the regular Park entry fee.

Prizes will be awarded for the heaviest stringer in each of 4 age groups, (2-6, 7-9, 10-12, and 13-16), as well as for the overall largest fish, largest bass, largest catfish and largest crappie. Two additional prizes for the smallest perch will be given to age groups 2-6 and 7-9.

Korth said all children should be able to go home with a nice prize from this year's event, thanks to the generosity of several major donors including Coletto Creek Power, LP, the TPWD Game Warden's Association and the Buddy Hartl Memorial Fund.
