Lake Gonzales (H-4) to be Lowered June 4 for Repairs

SEGUIN---- Beginning the evening of Sunday, June 4, 2006 Lake Gonzales (H-4) will be lowered approximately 18 to 24 inches below normal so that Guadalupe-Blanco River Authority (GBRA) hydroelectric crews can perform routine maintenance to the dam.

Lake Gonzales (H4) will be raised 6-8 inches beginning Friday evening, June 9, 2006 for weekend recreation use, and lowered again Sunday night, June 11, 2006 approximately 18 to 24 inches below normal so that crews can resume maintenance to the dam through Friday, June 16, 2006.

The public is advised that these scheduled operations may be completed before June 16, or may need to be extended for an additional period of time. When work is completed, the lake will be returned to normal level.

Operations may also be adjusted or canceled in the event of adverse weather conditions.

GBRA advises anyone using Lake Gonzales (H-4) for recreation purposes during this time to exercise caution, since lower lake levels may expose debris and other potential hazards that are normally underwater.
