

Boil Water Notification

Due to a major line break at the GBRA Port Lavaca Water Treatment Plant, the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) has required our public water system the Guadalupe Blanco River Authority Port Lavaca Water Treatment Plant , Public Water System number 0290005, to notify all customers to boil their water prior to consumption.

To ensure destruction of all harmful bacteria and other microbes, water for drinking, cooking and for making ice should be boiled and cooled prior to consumption. The water should be brought to a vigorous, roiling boil and then boiled for two minutes. In lieu of boiling, you may purchase bottled water or obtain water from some other suitable source.

When it is no longer necessary to boil the water, the water system officials will notify you that the water is safe for consumption. This rescind notice will be issued in the same manner as the Boil Water Notice.
