SEGUIN-The Guadalupe Blanco River Authority (GBRA) Port Lavaca Water Treatment Plant is requesting the immediate cooperation of all customers to CONSERVE water. Although water production is underway following the June 13 water outage, the system will not be fully restored until water lines are flushed and municipal storage tanks are refilled.

Unnecessary water use such as washing cars, watering lawns or filling swimming pools is affecting this process and may delay the restoration of pressure throughout the system. Please postpone these, and other unnecessary water uses, until public notice is provided that the water system has returned to normal.
