## **Lake Gonzales (H-4) Lowering Extended GBRA Advises Work May Be Completed Before or After June 30 Target Date**

SEGUIN---- The level of Lake Gonzales (H-4) will continue to be approximately 18 to 24 inches below normal so that Guadalupe-Blanco River Authority (GBRA) hydroelectric crews can continue routine maintenance to the dam.

Lake Gonzales (H-4) will be raised 6-8 inches, for recreation use beginning Friday evening, June 16 and lowered again Sunday evening, June 18. This schedule will continue for weekend use on Friday evening, June 23 with the lake being raised 6-8 inches, and lowered again Sunday evening, June 25 for repair work to resume.

The public is advised that these scheduled operations may be completed before June 30, or may need to be extended for an additional period of time. When work is completed, the lake will be returned to normal level and public notice will be provided.

Operations may also be adjusted or canceled in the event of adverse weather conditions.

GBRA advises anyone using Lake Gonzales (H-4) for recreation purposes during this time to exercise caution, since lower lake levels may expose debris and other potential hazards that are normally underwater.
