**Lake Placid (TP-4) to be Lowered June 25-29
for Routine Dam Maintenance**

SEGUIN---- Beginning the evening of Monday, June 25, Lake Placid (TP-4) will be lowered approximately 12 to 18 inches below the normal elevation so that Guadalupe-Blanco River Authority (GBRA) hydroelectric crews can perform routine maintenance to the dam.

GBRA officials advise that these scheduled operations maybe completed before June 29. Operations also maybe adjusted or canceled in the event of adverse weather conditions.

Lake Placid (TP-4) recreational users should exercise caution. Lower lake levels may expose debris and other potential hazards that normally are underwater.

The GBRA was established by the Texas Legislature in 1933 as a water conservation and reclamation district. GBRA provides stewardship for the water resources in its 10-county statutory district, which begins near the headwaters of the Guadalupe and Blanco rivers, ends at San Antonio Bay, and includes Kendall, Comal, Hays, Caldwell, Guadalupe, Gonzales, DeWitt, Victoria, Calhoun, and Refugio counties.
