Coletto Creek-A record 145 children tested their fishing skills during the GBRA Coletto Creek Park's Annual Kid's Fishing Tournament held Saturday, June 7, 2008. The tournament in its 15th year, is held at Coletto Creek Park located between Victoria and Goliad on Highway 59.

Fishermen ranged in age from 2 to 16, and came from as far away as Austin, Buda, and El Campo. The overall heaviest stringer weighing in at 45.86 pounds was a stringer of carp caught by Melanie Tesch of Victoria. The biggest fish was a gar that weighed 13.9 pounds, caught by Kyle Huber of Victoria. Dillon Sievers and Hunter Haug, both of Victoria, placed in a tie for smallest fish with 3-inch perch. The first place winners in the four different age groups were Kaliegh Knight of Shiner in the 2-6 age category with a stringer weight of 2.61 pounds, Jerod Moeller of Shiner in the 7-9 age group with a stringer weight of 6.62 pounds, Kyle Huber of Victoria in the 10-12 age group with a stringer weight of 23.30 pounds, and Melanie's stringer of 45.86 pounds won the 13-16 age group.

Every participant was a winner in this annual family-oriented tournament sponsored by the Guadalupe Blanco River Authority, the Texas Parks and Wildlife Game Wardens, and Academy Sports and Outdoors.

Plans are underway for the 16th Annual Kid's Tournament scheduled for Saturday, June 6, 2009.
