SEGUIN - Impending and rapidly changing weather conditions related to Hurricane Ike have prompted Guadalupe-Blanco River Authority officials to return Lake Dunlap to its normal pool elevation and to urge lake users at Dunlap, McQueeney and Placid to make arrangements to remove watercraft as soon as possible.

Additionally, GBRA officials are encouraging homeowner associations to open ramps on all lakes.

Lake users who choose to remove their watercrafts as a precaution should do so early and note the following:

Lake Dunlap will be at normal pool elevation as of Thursday morning to assist in the removal of watercraft. Routine maintenance at Lake Dunlap will be scheduled at a later date and the lake will be lowered at that time.

At Lake McQueeney, boat ramps at the Lake Breeze Ski Lodge are available for residents to remove watercraft.

At Lake Placid, the TXDOT boat ramp located at IH-10 will be open to allow residents to remove watercraft.

Over the next several days as Hurricane Ike approaches the Gulf coastline and potentially moves into the Guadalupe River Basin, upper-basin residents should tune to KWED 1580 AM radio station in Seguin for updates on river and lake conditions from GBRA as well as weather updates from meteorological officials.

The GBRA was established by the Texas Legislature in 1933 as a water conservation and reclamation district. GBRA provides stewardship for the water resources in its 10-county statutory district, which begins near the headwaters of the Guadalupe and Blanco rivers, ends at San Antonio Bay, and includes Kendall, Comal, Hays, Caldwell, Guadalupe, Gonzales, DeWitt, Victoria, Calhoun, and Refugio counties.
