Meadow Lake (Nolte) to be Lowered Oct 19 thru Nov 1 for Routine Dam Maintenance

SEGUIN---- Beginning Sunday, Oct. 19 Meadow Lake (Nolte) will be approximately 18 to 24 inches below normal so that Guadalupe-Blanco River Authority (GBRA) hydroelectric crews can perform routine maintenance to the dam.

The work will be completed by Friday, Oct. 31 and the lake level will be returned to its normal level by Saturday morning, Nov. 1.

The public is advised that these scheduled operations may be completed before Nov. 1, or may need to be extended for an additional period of time. Operations may also be adjusted or canceled in the event of adverse weather conditions.

GBRA advises anyone using Meadow Lake for recreation purpose during this time to exercise caution. Lower lake levels may expose debris and other potential hazards that are normally underwater.

The GBRA was established by the Texas Legislature in 1933 as a water conservation and reclamation district. GBRA provides stewardship for the water resources in its 10-county statutory district, which begins near the headwaters of the Guadalupe and Blanco rivers, ends at San Antonio Bay, and includes Kendall, Comal, Hays, Caldwell, Guadalupe, Gonzales, DeWitt, Victoria, Calhoun, and Refugio counties.
