## **Lake Dunlap Dam Maintenance to be Completed for Easter Holiday**

SEGUIN----Beginning the evening of Wednesday April 8, the water level at Lake Dunlap will start to refill and should return to its normal level by Friday morning, April 10, for the Easter holiday weekend.

Necessary dam maintenance required the lake to be lowered approximately 18 to 24 inches so that Guadalupe-Blanco River Authority (GBRA) hydroelectric crews could perform the work.

The GBRA was established by the Texas Legislature in 1933 as a water conservation and reclamation district. GBRA provides stewardship for the water resources in its 10-county statutory district, which begins near the headwaters of the Guadalupe and Blanco rivers, ends at San Antonio Bay, and includes Kendall, Comal, Hays, Caldwell, Guadalupe, Gonzales, DeWitt, Victoria, Calhoun, and Refugio counties.
