SEGUIN---The Guadalupe-Blanco River Authority hydroelectric maintenance crew has completed work on the McQueeney dam. The lake level will increase approximately three inches each day until Friday morning, May 22, when it will return to its normal level for the Memorial Day weekend.

Until the lake returns to its normal level, GBRA officials advise anyone using Lake McQueeney for recreational purposes to exercise caution. Lower lake levels may have exposed debris and other potential hazards that are normally underwater. For questions about Lake McQueeney levels please call GBRA(830)379-5822.

The GBRA was established by the Texas Legislature in 1933 as a water conservation and reclamation district. GBRA provides stewardship for the water resources in its 10-county statutory district, which begins near the headwaters of the Guadalupe and Blanco rivers, ends at San Antonio Bay, and includes Kendall, Comal, Hays, Caldwell, Guadalupe, Gonzales, DeWitt, Victoria, Calhoun, and Refugio counties.
