Modifications Open Lake Dunlap for Some Uses

SEGUIN, TX - Following additional clean up and restoration efforts by the Preserve Lake Dunlap Association, the Guadalupe-Blanco River Authority General Manager William "Bill" E. West has amended the Hydro Lake restrictions to allow limited access on Lake Dunlap. The modification for Lake Dunlap allows the use of motorized boats only with no towing of objects or persons effective noon Saturday, July 10, 2010 during daylight hours only. A revised chart detailing the modified restrictions for each of the Hydro Lake is available on the GBRA website (or attached to this release).

Restrictions imposed Wednesday, June 30, which allows the use of motorized boats to include towing of objects or individuals, and use of personal watercraft during daylight hours, but prohibits towing of inflatable objects and other water toys remain in effect on Lake McQueeney, Meadow Lake (Nolte), Lake Gonzales (H-4), Lake Wood (H-5) and only on Lake Placid from the dam to IH-35.

All original restrictions from June 10 remain in place on Lake Placid upstream of IH-10. Individuals who require access to restricted areas of Lake Placid to retrieve or secure personal property may continue to contact GBRA to obtain a permit.

Daylight hours are defined as 30 minutes before sunrise and 30 minutes after sunset.

The GBRA was established by the Texas Legislature in 1933 as a water conservation and reclamation district. GBRA provides stewardship for the water resources in its 10-county statutory district, which begins near the headwaters of the Guadalupe and Blanco rivers, ends at San Antonio Bay, and includes Kendall, Comal, Hays, Caldwell, Guadalupe, Gonzales, DeWitt, Victoria, Calhoun, and Refugio counties.

Uses on All Hydro Lakes - Dunlap, McQueeney, Placid, Meadow, H-4 and H-5 are restricted to daylight hours only, defined as 30 minutes before sunrise to 30 minutes after sunset.
