## Lake Wood Boat Ramp Temporarily Closed for Rebuild

GONZALES – The Guadalupe-Blanco River Authority Lake Wood Recreation Area boat ramp will close on Monday, Nov. 21 to deepen the existing ramp cove and prepare for the construction of new ramp.

“A new ramp will be built to better accommodate the safe launching of today's larger, heavier motor boats on the lake,” said Wilfred Korth, GBRA chief ranger.

The lake level is expected to remain the same level during construction and boaters wishing to launch their boats may use the Cost Monument boat ramp.

Construction of the new Lake Wood Recreation Area boat ramp is being funded by GBRA and a Texas Parks and Wildlife Department (TPWD) Boat Ramp Grant.

Construction is scheduled to be completed mid-January, and a new ramp should be installed and ready for use.

The GBRA was established by the Texas Legislature in 1933 as a water conservation and reclamation district. GBRA provides stewardship for the water resources in its 10-county statutory district, which begins near the headwaters of the Guadalupe and Blanco rivers, goes on to San Antonio Bay, and includes Kendall, Comal, Hays, Caldwell, Guadalupe, Gonzales, DeWitt, Victoria, Calhoun, and Refugio counties.
