GBRA's Coletto Creek Park to Host July 4 Fireworks Display

Coletto Creek Park will host a low altitude fireworks display at the reservoir starting at 9:00 p.m. Thursday, July 4, 2013. Coletto Creek Park is located midway between Victoria and Goliad off of Highway 59. A day-use entry fee into the park is \$10 per vehicle.

Coletto Creek Park is the public access to the 3,100-acre reservoir. The park offers picnic areas that include picnic tables and barbecue grills, a marked swimming area, a boat launch, 200-foot lighted fishing pier, sand volleyball courts, playgrounds, hike and bike trails, group-use pavilions, and overnight camping facilities.
