From the intersection of Hwy 59 and FM 2987 in Fannin, go north on FM 2987 approximately 3.6 miles. Turn right on Sulphur Creek Est Rd and travel 2.6 miles to the end of that road. The event will be at the entry gate to the easement property.

In the event of inclement weather, the event will be relocated to Coletto Creek Park's enclosed Pavilion C, 365 Coletto Park Road, Victoria, Texas, 77905.

### **About the Guadalupe-Blanco River Trust**

Founded in 2001, the GBR Trust is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit land trust organization that was developed to conserve land in the Guadalupe River Watershed for its natural, recreational, scenic, historic and productive value. Its mission is to preserve the unique natural heritage of the Guadalupe watershed for future generations, by protecting open landscapes, working farms and ranches, and wildlife habitat through conservation easements, education, and outreach that connects people to the water and the land.
