Voluntary Swimming Restriction Lifted at GBRA's Coletto Creek Park and Reservoir

The Guadalupe-Blanco River Authority completed testing for *E. coli* bacteria at its Coletto Creek Reservoir swimming area and dam. Tests indicated a reading of 5 most probable number (mpn) colonies per 100 milliliters (ml) at the swimming area and 1 mpn per 100 ml at the dam. The average reading for the 12-month period ending April 11 was 5.7 mpn per 100 ml for the park and 5.3 mpn per 100 ml at the dam. All of these readings are well below the Texas Commission for Environmental Quality's (TCEQ) threshold for human contact recreation of 125 mpn per 100 ml. As a result, the Coletto Creek Park and Reservoir staff lifted the voluntary water contact restriction it had implemented at the swimming area effective noon Thursday, July 14, 2016.
