Statement Regarding Reduction in Canyon Releases for Labor Day Weekend

SEGUIN – Beginning at 3 a.m. Friday, Sept. 2, 2016, the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers will allow flow releases from Canyon Reservoir to be reduced to about 480 cubic feet per second (cfs) where they will remain through Tuesday, Sept. 6, 2016, at which time the release rate will be re-evaluated. As always, this plan may change in response to rainfall or other factors
