Notice Regarding Canyon Releases

Based on current conditions, releases from Canyon Lake near Sattler will remain around 150 cfs through the extended weekend. As always, flow releases may change in response to rainfall or other factors.

In the absence of rainfall upstream, releases will likely decline throughout the summer based on several factors including reduced inflows to the reservoir and permit requirements.

The GBRA was established by the Texas Legislature in 1933 as a water conservation and reclamation district. GBRA provides stewardship for the water resources in its 10-county statutory district, which begins near the headwaters of the Guadalupe and Blanco rivers, goes on to San Antonio Bay, and includes Kendall, Comal, Hays, Caldwell, Guadalupe, Gonzales, DeWitt, Victoria, Calhoun, and Refugio counties.
