The Guadalupe-Blanco River Authority (GBRA) is requesting sealed bids from qualified, responsible bidders to provide all labor, material, tools, and equipment to perform all work required consisting of 2,371 linear feet of water line, 1,217 linear feet of steel encasement, 151 linear feet of jacking and boring pipe, and related appurtenances associated with the work on FM 110 North, located in Hays County. All qualified firms including Small, Minority, and Women Owned Businesses are encouraged to submit bids in response to this bid invitation.
