In accordance with the provisions of the Texas Open Meetings Act, Chapter 551, Texas Government Code, the Guadalupe-Blanco River Authority (GBRA), whose principal office is in the City of Seguin, Guadalupe County, Texas, hereby gives notice of a meeting of its **BOARD OF DIRECTORS** to be held at the **Guadalupe-Blanco River Authority William E. West, Jr., Annex Building, 905 Nolan, Seguin, Guadalupe County, Texas, at 10:00 a.m., on Wednesday, November 14, 2018.**

Subjects to be considered for discussion at such meeting include:

CALL TO ORDER

Chair's consideration of posted notices. Pledge of Allegiance. Welcome guests.

PUBLIC COMMENTS

GENERAL MANAGER/CEO ITEMS

The General Manager/CEO and staff may report on, and the Board may discuss, executive reports and/or issues relating to GBRA activities including without limitation, the following: GBRA water and sewer utility operations, hydroelectric operations, GBRA facilities management including plants and dams, safety, water resources planning and operation, construction management, economic and community development, project development, accounting and finance, records management, grants and financial assistance, human resources, information technology, communications, social media, education programs, resource protection, weather and climate, river flows and other scientific issues, non-profit entities partnering with GBRA, water quality services, community affairs, environmental programs, and stewardship.

ACTION ITEMS

7. Consideration of and possible action approving the January 1, 2018, Actuarial Valuation for the Retirement Plan for Employees of the Guadalupe-Blanco River Authority and the recommended Plan contribution of \$1,128,049 included therein.
8. Consideration of and possible action approving an amendment to the GBRA Fiscal Year 2019 Work Plan and Budget to establish rates for the Carrizo Groundwater Supply Project and the Canyon Lake Gorge.
9. Consideration of and possible action authorizing the General Manager/CEO to seek bids and to negotiate and execute contracts for sludge dewatering, hauling and disposal for Western Canyon Water Treatment Facility.
10. Consideration of and possible action to authorize the General Manager/CEO to negotiate and execute a settlement in the contested case relating to GBRA's application to amend Certificate of Adjudication No. 18-3863 (the "Womack" Water Right).

ITEMS FOR EXECUTIVE SESSION

12. The Board may meet in Executive Session as authorized by the listed sections of Chapter 551, Texas Government Code, to discuss the following matters:

- a. advice from legal counsel about pending or contemplated litigation, proposed settlements, and the impact of pending or contemplated litigation on GBRA projects and proposed projects. This includes without limitation, the following matters: *LULAC v. Edwards Aquifer Authority* (United States District Court for the Western District of Texas, San Antonio Division); *NBL-300 Group v GBRA* on remand to District Court from the 4th Court of Appeals, San Antonio; Application to the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality by GBRA for GBRA's Mid-Basin surface water permit (State Office of Administrative Hearings); Applications to the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality for a bed and banks permit filed by San Antonio Water Systems; GBRA application to amend Certificate of Adjudication No. 18-3863 (a.k.a., the "Womack" Water Right); Applications by Riverdale Land and Cattle Company to amend Certificates of Adjudication in the San Antonio River Basin; Other contested applications to the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality by GBRA for water rights or amendments to water rights; Section 551.071, Texas Government Code;
- b. briefing and advice from legal counsel relating to ongoing negotiations, potential liabilities and other matters covered by legal counsel's duty of confidentiality, including without limitation, legal and regulatory issues relating to GBRA's Carrizo Groundwater Supply Project, Caldwell and Gonzales Counties, including groundwater leases, permits, water treatment, water pipelines and other issues related to the Project; briefing and advice regarding taxes assessed by Gonzales County taxing authorities for property on certain Lake Wood lots prior to the termination of the GBRA Lake Wood lease program on December 31, 2017; briefing and advice from legal counsel relating to GBRA surface and groundwater rights and permits throughout the Guadalupe River Basin; Section 551.071, Texas Government Code;
- c. deliberation on matters relating to the purchase, exchange, lease, or value of real property interests and advice from legal counsel on those matters, including without limitation issues relating to the lease or ownership of groundwater and surface water rights in the Guadalupe River Basin and/or within the boundaries of GBRA and right-of-way acquisitions for GBRA-related projects within the boundaries of GBRA; Sections 551.071 and 551.072, Texas Government Code;
- d. commercial or financial information, relating to various matters, including without limitation GBRA's Lower Basin Project, GBRA's Carrizo Groundwater Supply Project; Section 551.087, Texas Government Code;
- e. appointment, employment, evaluation, reassignment, duties, discipline, or dismissal of a public officer (including an executive manager) or employee or hear a complaint or charge against an officer or employee; Section 551.074, Texas Government Code.

The Board may take final action on any of the above mentioned matters while convened in open session pursuant to Chapter 551 of the Texas Government Code.
