

Canyon Reservoir Advisory
October 10, 2019

The Guadalupe-Blanco River Authority (GBRA) will reduce the water release rate from Canyon Reservoir Monday, October 21, due to continued low inflows into Canyon Lake. As current conditions persist, releases from Canyon Dam will be approximately ~60 cubic feet per second (cfs).

Over the past 45 days, inflows upstream of Canyon Reservoir have averaged less than 90 cfs which limits the releases from Canyon Reservoir to that equal to the inflow. Any variations to flows are made in response to rainfall, changes to inflows, or to meet downstream water supply commitments.
