Sparks will Fly on the Fourth of July at Coletto Creek Park *Sponsored by Coletto Creek Power*

VICTORIA, Texas – Guadalupe-Blanco River Authority's Coletto Creek Park will host its annual Red, White & Boom! fireworks display Thursday, July 4, 2019. The annual celebration is made possible through a generous sponsorship from Luminant—Coletto Creek Power.

Coletto Creek Park, on the shores of the Coletto Creek Reservoir between Goliad and Victoria, hosts the annual low-altitude pyrotechnic display over the reservoir. Spectators are encouraged grab a blanket, join friends and family and spend the evening enjoying the star-spangled spectacle of fireworks.

The 190-acre park has picnic areas complete with barbeque grills, a marked swimming area, boat ramp access, sand volleyball courts, playgrounds, nature trails, covered pavilions, a lighted fishing pier, and overnight camping areas with RV hookups. Public access to the 3,100-acre reservoir also is available. Park entrance fee is \$12 per vehicle.
